



STUDENT WRITING CONTESTS

Write-a-Story Contest Rules and Guidelines

Scope's Write-a-Story contest is open to students in grades 4-12. One entry per person. Students may not submit entries as pairs or groups.

All entries must be original. By entering, students warrant and represent that their entry is their original work, and the winner grants to Scholastic the right to edit, publish, promote, and otherwise use his/her entry without further notice or compensation.

Entries will be judged on criteria including development of character and plot; grammar, spelling, and punctuation; originality; and length (800-3,000 words). The winner will be notified within two months of the contest deadline by mail and will be announced on the *Scope* website.
